

Application Instructions

Nematodes should be used as soon as possible upon delivery. The product may be stored at 4 to 8°C as per the expiring date on the package. Do not freeze or expose to more than 35°C.

Application conditions

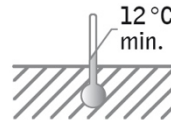
In heated glasshouses and tunnels nematodes can be used all year round. The soil surface should be moist and should stay moist (not soaking) for two weeks.



Avoid application in direct sun light.



Apply in the evening, when overcast or during rainfall.



The soil / growing media temperature must be above 12°C for at least several hours per day. However nemaplus and nematop cool may be applied to soil /growing media above 8°C.

Apply the nematodes with a watering can or with the Nema-Sprayer (hose end feeder).

Dissolve the pack contents in a bucket with 1-10 litres of water according to the table below. Rinse the pack since nematodes often cling to the packaging. Stir the stock solution until all lumps are dissolved. Repeat stirring every 15 minutes.

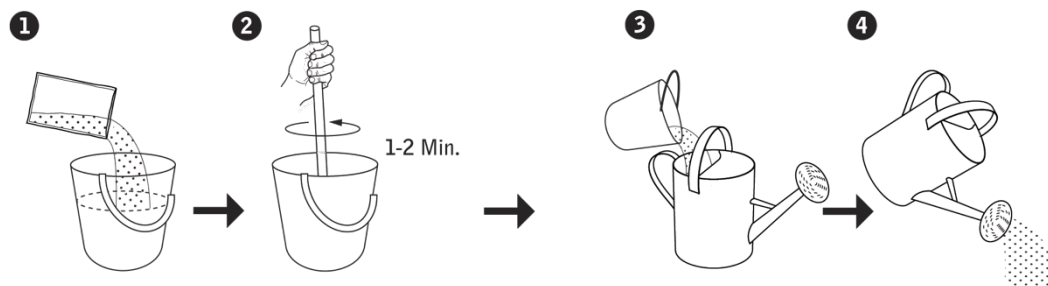
Irrigate within 30 minutes after application to wash nematodes into the soil.



Pack size	treats	dissolve pack in	Nema-Sprayer
5 million	10 m ²	1 l of water	200 ml
10 million	20 m ²	2 l of water	400 ml
25 million	50 m ²	5 l of water	1 litre
50 million	100 m ²	10 l of water	2 x 1 litre

Add 1 litre of your stock solution to a watering can and top up with 9 liters of tap water.



10 litres diluted solution in the watering can will treat 10 m². Repeat the procedure until all of the stock solution is used up.
